

Chapter Voter Eligibility Policy 2026-2027

TO ALL OFFICIALS

Members who wish to have voting privileges must be current with all State/Local dues and fees by the specific meeting attended in order to receive credit for that meeting (not current with dues/fees = no credit), have attended and received credit for **four (4) out of the (6) Chapter meetings**.

Members who want voting privileges must be current on all state and local dues and fees before the meeting they attend. If a member is not compliant with their financial obligations, they will not receive credit for that meeting.

Attendance at the election meeting does not count toward voting eligibility. Additionally, members must attend and receive credit for either the TASO State meeting, the Regional Clinic, or complete the TASO Online Clinic modules.

Chapter Meeting Attendance Appeal Policy

The Chapter Attendance Committee will publish a list of all officials who received credit for attending either in-person or virtual meetings on the chapter webpage within 72 hours of the meeting date. Each Member is responsible for reviewing this list and submitting an appeal if their name is missing. Members have one week (seven days) from the posting date to submit their appeal to receive attendance credit. If you wish to appeal, Members shall contact your division representative in writing and cc the recording secretary. If you do not appeal within this timeframe, you will be ineligible for credit.
