BASKETBALL NOMINATION FOR HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP

Submit to the TASO-Basketball Awards Committee

- I. PURPOSE The selection of individuals who have contributed distinguished service to this organization and to the sport of basketball.
- II. QUALIFICATIONS OF CANDIDATES FOR HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP a. The candidate must have been a member of TASO-Basketball for 15 years. b. The candidate must have served as a chapter, district, or state officer. c. The candidate must be retired from active membership and basketball officiating for a minimum of three (3) years. d. The candidate should have gained prominence as a basketball official in the state. e. The candidate must be recommended by the local chapter of which he/she is/was a member, or by the TASO-Basketball Board of Directors.
- III. METHOD OF SELECTING CANDIDATES a. Individuals shall be selected by the Committee from the list of nominations. 1. Any chapter or the TASO-Basketball Board of Directors may submit names for consideration for Honorary Life Membership. 2. Submit four (4) copies of the person's background to the Committee Chairman 3. Nomination forms may be obtained from the TASO office. 4. The Chairman shall submit a copy of the person's background to each member for a vote. b. The Committee, with the approval of the TASO-Basketball Board of Directors, reserves the right to waive any of the above requirements. c. Recommendations for Honorary Life membership shall be presented to the Executive Director by April 15.
