

Eligibility to Officiate Policy 2026-2027

TO ALL OFFICIALS

Every official is required to complete all off-court tasks. If you have not addressed these items yet, please do so immediately. The first scrimmages are scheduled for October and November. Officials are required to update their own calendars regarding their availability. Contact the varsity assigners if you have any questions.

THINGS TO DO

LOCAL REQUIREMENTS

Local Dues (\$40) & Assigning Fees (\$50): to remain a member in good standing of the RGV Chapter, you must pay your dues and assigning fees before games can be assigned. Payment is also required to receive voting credit for your attendance at the in-person meeting or the virtual Chapter meeting. TASO EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

State Meeting/Regional Clinic/Online Clinic (modules): You must complete one of the following to be assigned games: attend the State meeting (date to be announced), a Regional Clinic (date to be announced), or complete the TASO Online Clinic (8 modules). The Online Clinic can be accessed on your TASO Portal page.

Rules & Mechanics Tests (2-person / 3-person): These tests are available on your TASO Portal page. You need a score of at least 70 to officiate sub-varsity games (middle school, freshman, sophomore, and JV) and at least 90 to officiate varsity games. To be eligible for varsity games, you must complete all three tests (Rules, 2-person Mechanics, and 3-person Mechanics). A score of 90 is required on all tests to qualify for playoff games.

ARBITERSPORTS

Each RGV Chapter member has an Arbiter Sports account. You should either open a new account or update your existing one with your personal information. Ensure your calendar reflects the days you are unavailable and the school sites you prefer not to officiate. Additionally, upload a professional photo to help identify yourself. This website is essential for communication with Chapter members and for game assignments. Please monitor this website daily during the season.
