

Rio Grande Valley Chapter Playoff Policy 2026-2027

- Be a member in good standing with TASO and Chapter (pass background check, submit all forms required, be current with all state and local dues/fees by invoice date, no current year assessed ethics violation suspension or probation imposed)
- Attend and receive credit for 4 of 6 scheduled meetings
- Attend and complete TASO State, Regional or On-Line Clinic by designated dates (UIL required date of submittal for Regional/State Tournament selection)
- Officiate 18 Varsity games (excluding tournament games)
- Pass all required testing exams (Rules, Mechanics, 3 & 2 person) with a minimum of 90 by designated dates (UIL required date of submittal for Regional/State Tournament selection)
- Participate and complete three (3) assigned Varsity scrimmages of three (3) hour length
- Attend one (1) Board approved camp every other year effective 2021-22. (Example: If camp attended in 2021, seasons 2021-22 and 2022-23 requirement is satisfied. Must attend camp again in 2023 to satisfy future requirement). Verification and documentation of attendance with completion is responsibility of official

Chapter Meeting Attendance Appeal Policy

The Chapter Attendance Committee will publish a list of all officials who received credit for attending either in-person or virtual meetings on the chapter webpage within 72 hours of the meeting date. Each Member is responsible for reviewing this list and submitting an appeal if their name is missing. Members have one week (seven days) from the posting date to submit their appeal to receive attendance credit. If you wish to appeal, Members shall contact your division representative in writing and cc the recording secretary. If you do not appeal within this timeframe, you will be ineligible for credit.

- Note: Those who become eligible for playoff assignments does not guarantee assignment selection. Qualifying means, the Chapter member is in the “pool” of officials who are to be eligible for playoff assignments. Coaches will be notified if an official is or is not available
